The 3 Steps of Direct Instruction



Modeling: The teacher demonstrates the skill while the learner observes.



Guided Practice: During the **guided practice**, teacher feedback to correct and incorrect responding follows a specific sequence

- 1. The learner practices the skill with teacher support.
- 2. The teacher systematically delivers prompts as needed to facilitate skill transfer.

<u>Student Incorrect Responding</u>: Error Correction **Procedure**:

- 1. Explicitly communicate the learning error to the learner,
- 2. Model the targeted skill again
- 3. Request the learner to re-attempt the skill
- 4. Provide positive reinforcement (specific positive praise) for correct responding.
- 5. Repeat as necessary

<u>Student Correct Responding</u>: Provide **positive reinforcement** (specific positive praise) to communicate to the learner they are responding correctly.



Independent Practice: The learner performs the skill on their own to examine if the knowledge was transferred
