The 6 Steps of Recruiting Reinforcement



Introduce the recruiting skill to the learner

- Discuss the importance of gaining feedback to know if the learner is "on track" while working on an assignment.
- Discuss the importance of gaining feedback to know if the learner completed an activity correctly before moving on to the next assignment.



Identify recruiting questions

- Ensure the learner is comfortable with how to ask the teacher for feedback.
- Make sure the recruiting questions are authentic for the learner.



Teach the learner appropriate times to recruit reinforcement

- Teach the learner to identify when a teacher is "too busy"
- Identify situations when the teacher is available



Discuss the intervention with the teachers who are involved

- Discuss the importance of giving positive feedback to the learner
- Discuss the importance of still giving positive feedback to the learner if the learner isn't on track (i.e. specific praise for the effort).



Student attempts to use the skill in the classroom

- Ensure the teacher knows the student will be trying out the skill
- The student may need a visual cue (i.e. card that says, "ask for feedback")

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Monitor the learner's progress

- Check in with the teacher to identify if the student is using the skill at the appropriate times
- Ensure the learner is comfortable with using the skill
- Make adjustments as necessary after checking in with the teacher and learner
