Knows What to Do in Emergency Drills and Real Emergencies (SCS.24)

Role Play Script

SETTING: Track (around football field)

PEOPLE: 2 students, 911 operator

SCRIPT

STUDENT 1: *Falls to ground after running second lap around track.*

STUDENT 2: *Runs to student 1, checks for pulse/breathing* "Hey, can you hear me?"

STUDENT 1: *No response, but breathing heavily and wheezing*

STUDENT 2: *Pulls out cell phone, dials 911*

911 OPERATOR: "911 what is your emergency?"

STUDENT 1: "My friend was running and then fell, she is breathing but really hard."

911 OPERATOR: "What is your location?"

STUDENT 1: " _____ middle school, on the track."

911 OPERATOR: "Inside or outside track?"

STUDENT 1: "Outside"

911 OPERATOR: "Is anyone else injured or experiencing breathing problems?"

STUDENT 1: "NO"

911 OPERATOR: "Does your friend have an inhaler?"

STUDENT 1: "I'll check her bag." *Runs to bleachers & gets bag, remains on the phone

911 OPERATOR: "Okay, please stay on the phone. What is your name?"

STUDENT 1: "Dylan _____." *Checks bag*

911 OPERATOR: "Dispatch is heading to you"

STUDENT 1: "I found one" *While running back to student 1*

SCHOOL NURSE: *Runs on to the track*

STUDENT 1: "The nurse just showed up" *Hands phone to nurse*

Role Play Script

SETTING: Bathroom in 8th Grade Hallway

PEOPLE: 2 students, 911 operator

SCRIPT

STUDENT 1: "Hey, do you smell something?"

STUDENT 2: "Kinda"

STUDENT 1: "Like smoke?" *thick smoke begins to come from under one of the bathroom stalls*

STUDENT 2: "Yeah, I think so. I think I see it too. We need to get out of here"

STUDENT 1: *Pulls out cell phone, dials 911. While running out of bathroom & exiting building*

STUDENT 2: *Runs out of bathroom, finds staff in hallway & explains what they smelled*

911 OPERATOR: "911 what's your emergency?"

STUDENT 1: "I think there's a fire at my school."

911 OPERATOR: "Where are you?"

STUDENT 1: " _____ middle school."

911 OPERATOR: "Where in the building do you think there is a fire?"

STUDENT 1: "8th grade girls bathroom, I smelled smoke & saw smoke."

911 OPERATOR: "Dispatch is on it's way. What is your name?"

STUDENT 1: " Dylan _____."

911 OPERATOR: " Okay Dylan, are you a student? "

STUDENT 1: "Yes, in 8th grade"

911 OPERATOR: "I'm going to keep you on the phone until help arrives. The fire department is 2 minutes out. Are you out of the building?"

STUDENT 1: "Yes & my friend told a teacher, other people are coming outside now."

Role Play Script

SETTING: Field Trip

PEOPLE: 2 students, 911 operator

SCRIPT

STUDENT 1: **Looks around**

STUDENT 2: "Uh, did we miss the bus?"

STUDENT 1: "Pretty sure we did."

STUDENT 2: "Okay, let's find someone who works here to help?"

STUDENT 1: **Nods head** "Yeah, but let's stay together"

STUDENT 1 & STUDENT 2: **Looking for an employee**

STUDENT 1: "I'm not seeing anyone and it's almost 3:00"

STUDENT 2: "I'm gonna call 911"

STUDENT 1: "Okay"

STUDENT 1: **Takes out cell phone, dials 911**

911 OPERATOR: "911 what is your emergency?"

STUDENT 2: "My friend & I are lost. We were on a field trip with our class & can't find anyone."

911 OPERATOR: "Where are you?"

STUDENT 2: " _____, by the community college."

911 OPERATOR: "What is your name & your friend's name?"

STUDENT 2: "I'm Dylan _____ & my friend is Jolene _____"

911 OPERATOR: "Dylan, you & your friend stay together. Is there anywhere you can sit down and remain until PD arrives?"

STUDENT 2: "Yes, there's a bench in the lobby"

911 OPERATOR: "Good, sit there with Jolene. PD is on their way. If you see or talk to any other people, let me know. I'm going to stay on the phone with you until help arrives."

STUDENT 2: **Motions for Student 2 to sit on bench with her**

STUDENT 1: **Sits on bench**

STUDENT 2: "Okay, we are sitting"

911 OPERATOR: "What school do you go to?"

STUDENT 2: " _____ middle school"

911 OPERATOR: "When PD arrives they will ask for your parents names & phone number. Do you know that information?"

STUDENT 2: "Yes, _____ & _____, my mom's cell is _____-____-____"

911 OPERATOR: "Great, does your friend know her parents' contact information?"

STUDENT 1: **Nods**
