Scenario 1-Acquaintance

Setting:	People:	Props:	Script:
Hallway	Custodian & Student	Broom	<p>Student: *Sees custodian in hallway, opening closet door*</p> <p>Custodian: *Glances at student & gives a friendly smile*</p> <p>Student: *Gives a small wave with their hand*</p> <p>Student: “Hey! Hope you’re having a good day!”</p> <p>Custodian: “Thanks, you too.”</p>

Scenario 2-Acquaintance

Setting:	People:	Script:
Auditorium for an assembly	3 students	<p>Student 1 & Student 2: *Sitting next to each other*</p> <p>Student 3: *Looking for an open seat, sees 1 next to students 1& 2, walks to open seat*</p> <p>Student 3: Asks Students 1 & 2 “Hey, is it okay if I sit here?”</p> <p>Student 1: “Sure”</p> <p>Student 3: *Sits down* Assembly ends *Gets up to leave*</p> <p>Student 3: To students 1 & 2 “Have a great day!”</p> <p>Students 1 & 2: “You too!”</p>

Setting:	People:	Props:	Script:
Lunch room	2 students	Cell phone	<p>Student 1 & Student 2: *Sitting at table*</p> <p>Student 1: *Shows student 2 phone* “Do you think I should try this cut next time I get my hair done?”</p> <p>Student 2: “Ehhh I’m not sure, it looks really short.”</p> <p>Student 1: “I know, that’s why I want your opinion. I really liked it last time it was shorter though.”</p> <p>Student 2: “That’s true, you should do it then!”</p> <p>Student 1: “Okay! I think I’m going to-next Friday after school.”</p> <p>Student 2: “You’ll have to send me a pic once it’s done.”</p>

Setting:	People:	Script:
Passing Period	2 students	<p>Student 1: *Opening door to office*</p> <p>Student 2: “You’re headed in here too? Good or bad?”</p> <p>Student 1: “Good-picking up my homework that I left at home. My mom brought it for me. What about you?”</p> <p>Student 2: “Hopefully good; meeting with Mrs. Martin, trying to change my elective schedule so I can take Drawing 1 instead of choir.”</p> <p>Student 1: “I see, good luck!”</p> <p>Student 2: “Thanks!
