Uses Slang and Idioms in Appropriate Settings (SC.9)

Role Play Script

SETTING/PEOPLE: Math class, teacher in hallway talking to principal, students to be working independently

Slang Use: Inappropriate setting

Script:

Student 1: *Leans towards Student 2*

Student 2: “Hey, need something?” *Looks towards classroom door

Student 1: “Ah-nevermind. We can talk after study skills.”

Student 2: “Alright then, I’ll make sure I wait for you & we can walk outside together.”

SETTING/PEOPLE: Bus, sitting with friends, bus aide located in front of students in a seat

Slang Use: Appropriate setting, but adult too close

Script:

Bus Aide: “Hey guys, voices at level 1 please. I can’t hear Danielle asking me a question.”

Group of 3 Students: *Talking about weekend plans*

Student 1: “For sure, sorry about that.” *Looks to peers in seats around him*

Bus Aide: “It’s okay, thank you.”

SETTING/PEOPLE: Lunch room

Slang Use: Appropriate setting, adult is far enough away

Script:

Student 1: *Sits at table with group of students*

Student 2: “BTW did you guys know that Mr. Watkins has a pet iguana?”

Student 1: “OMG stop, no way?”

Student 2: “Yep, saw a pic of it today in class.”

Student 3: “I figured he had a cat...or something.”

Student 1: “Uh-no way, he said he’s allergic. Remember?”
