PEER LISTENING

Student 1: *Continues reading* Student 2: "Like really bad…" Student 1: *Shifts in seat, away from Student 1 Student 2: "Sorry, I know you're trying to read. Last question… Is this your first time reading this book?"
3.	Setting: Classroom Student 1: "So that's why I think we should make a model of a compound, not just an elementary substance for our partner project" Student 2: "Sure, suresounds good." *Looking through backpack* Student 1: "Maybe we should pause on this.
